

ULVA ISLAND IS A PICTURESQUE, PREDATOR-FREE SANCTUARY FOR NATIVE & ENDEMIC BIRDS AND PLANTS.



Situated in the middle of Stewart Island's Paterson Inlet, Ulva Island is only a 10 minute boat ride from Golden Bay Wharf, Stewart Island.

It is 267 ha in size, 7.8 ha is privately owned. Approx. 3.5 kms long and 1.5 kms wide. Easy gravel tracks with steps, mainly flat with short stretches of beach.

In 1899, Ulva Island became the first reserve in the Stewart Island area. The Island was made predator-free in the late 1990's and continues today as a sanctuary for the protection of flora and wildlife.

During the 1860's Charles Trill an Orkney Islander settled on Ulva Island, opening a store in 1871 and, later in 1872, the first Post Office in the Stewart Island area.

Clad in near-pristine, primeval, native rainforest, with towering podocarp trees, mosses, delicate ferns and exquisite orchids in season.

Native and endemic land birds, shore birds and insect-life, along with surrounding marine life along Ulva Island's shoreline make up the island's key fauna.

1 Ulva Island Birds & Forest

HALF DAY

Key birds on Ulva Island include: saddleback, yellowhead (mohua), robin, rifleman, red and yellow-crowned parakeet, weka, kaka (parrot), kiwi, wood pigeon, brown creeper, morepork, little blue penguin, plus other common native birds. Kiwi are seen occasionally.
